Parental Objection to Release of Student Information to Military Recruiters, College/University Recruiters, or Prospective Employers

Public high schools must give the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of students to military recruiters, college/university recruiters, and prospective employers if the recruiters request the information (P.L. 107-110, Section 9528; 10 USC 503). However, students or their parents have the right to instruct the school in writing that this information is not to be released.
